

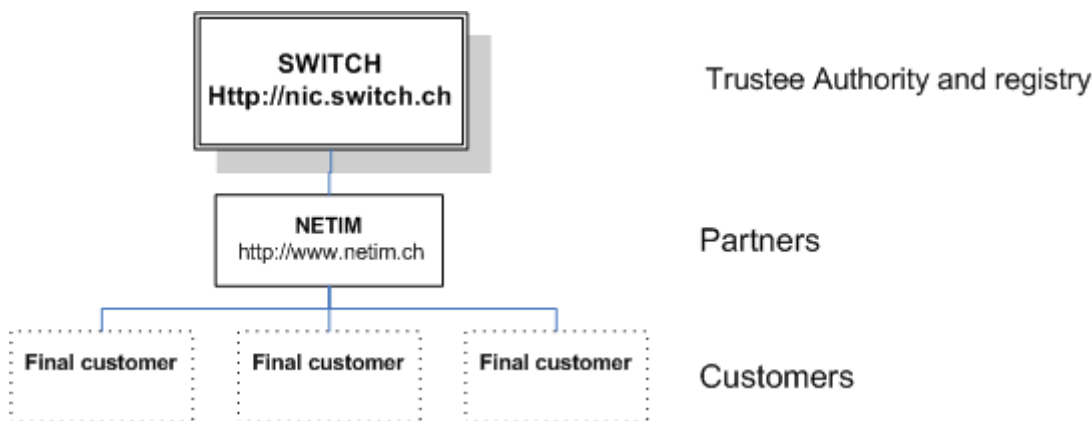
ANNEXE CH - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE EXTENSIONS .CH .LI

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .CH or .LI Extensions implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-CH.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

CLAUSE CH.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

CH.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for these Extensions



CH.1.2. NETIM® act as an official partner of SWITCH for the management of .CH and .LI domain names.

CLAUSE CH.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

CH.2.1 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, all currently applicable laws and regulations as well as the regulations concerning Extensions, defined by SWITCH and consultable at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted these contractual documents (below, the "NICCH Regulations") which link him to the Registry. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

CLAUSE CH.3: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

CH.3.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of NETIM®, a request for transfer of a Domain Name from another SWITCH's partner or from SWITCH to NETIM®, following the procedure specified on our site and in compliance with NICCH Regulations:

CH.3.2 The client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must provide a valid authorization code to NETIM®. Otherwise the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM®

CH.3.3 The transfer to NETIM® does not include any renewal for the Domain Name.

CH.4 In the context of a transfer of a Domain Name to another SWITCH's partner or to SWITCH , the authorisation codes can be obtained in the Manager and are sent by electronic mail to the Client's email address.

CLAUSE CH.4: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

CH.4.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, NETIM® shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall then be disabled for a period of fourteen (14) calendar days during which all NETIM®'s associated services shall no longer be available. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "quarantine" status

CH.4.2 If a Domain Name has been destroyed with the past fourteen (14) calendar days, it can be reactivated subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to NETIM® when carrying out these procedures:

- i) restoration is only possible from a technical point of view for the so-called "quarantine" period, which is the fourteen (14) day period between the destruction of the Domain Name by NETIM® and its destruction by the Registry
- ii) the restoration procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by one (1) year the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the previous expiry date.

CLAUSE CH.5: MANAGEMENT OF DISPUTES

CH.5.1 The registry prescribes specific regulations and a procedure for settling differences relative to domain names in .CH and .LI ("Settlement of differences" below), that can be consulted at the following address:

CLAUSE CH.6: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CH.6.1 The regulations laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .CH or .LI extensions, are imposed by SWITCH in charge of these different Extensions and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM®'s control.

CH.6.2 In the case where the special terms and conditions herein have been modified, NETIM® shall notify the client at least one (1) month before they come into force. If the Client does not accept them, NETIM® is entitled to terminate the Agreement without penalty for termination and without compensation entitlement for the Client, in compliance with the General Terms and Conditions CG-ND.
