

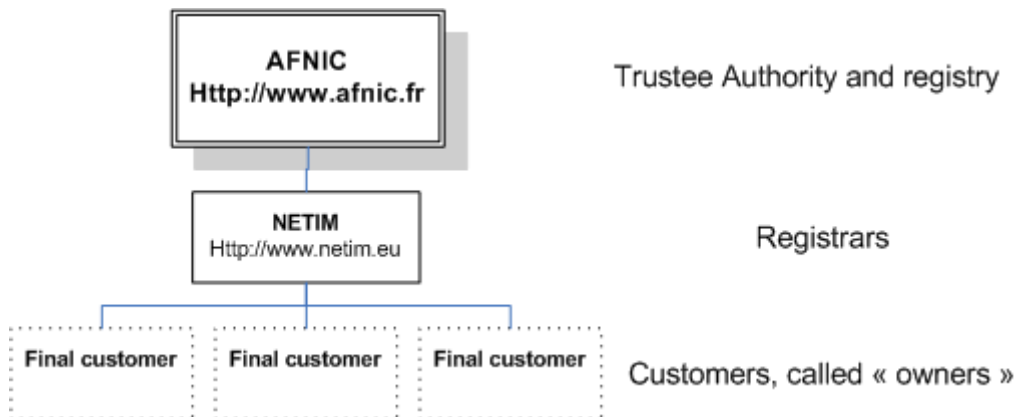
ANNEX FR - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTLD .FR

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration and use of a .FR Domain (and its second level) implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-FR.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

SECTION FR.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

FR.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system this Extension



FR.1.2 NETIM® is a member of AFNIC and act as an official registrar for the management of .FR domain names

SECTION FR.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

FR.2.1 Domain Names under this Extension are registered on a "*first come, first served*" basis, unless if exception is made by AFNIC (i.e. for prohibited or reserved terms).

FR.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws and regulations as well as regulations specific to the Extension, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and approved this contractual document (below, the "FR Regulations") which links him to the Registry. The present special terms do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

FR.2.4 Disputes relative to the choice and to the registration of Domain Names in this Extension are subject to different regulations and procedures for the resolution of disputes, detailed below in section FR.5, to which the Client accepts to comply when registering the Domain Name.

SECTION FR.3: SPECIAL REQUIEREMENTS

FR.3.1 Regarding FR Regulations, the administrative contact must reside in France.

FR.3.2 Regarding FR Regulations, domain names that correspond to the name of a municipality or town in France are reserved for the local administration

FR.3.3 Regarding FR Regulations, the name servers (DNS) of the domain name must be correctly configured as specified in the Registry's technical specifications

This point must be verified in order to perform the following operations: registration, transfer, trade, nameservers change.

SECTION FR.4: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

FR.4.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of NETIM®, a transfer request (also referred to as "change of delegation") for a Domain Name in .FR from another registrar to NETIM® (also referred to as "incoming transfer") according to the procedure specified on our site, and in compliance with FR Regulations:

FR.4.2 The transfer does not take effect immediately and requires approval for the transfer from the Client's former Registrar. The latter has a fifteen (15) day period to submit this opposition to the AFNIC, the effect of which shall be to suspend the procedure for an additional period of six (6) weeks. During this period, the Client is responsible for cancelling the transfer with NETIM®, or for proceeding with the required procedures with the former Registrar so that it shall accept the transfer. Subsequently, the transfer of a domain in .FR can take two (2) to six (6) weeks, unless the former Registrar speeds up the procedure by explicitly expressing its agreement with the Registry.

FR.4.3 In the context of a transfer of a Domain Name to another Registrar (also referred to as "outgoing transfer"), NETIM® shall systematically refuse any transfer if the registrar-lock functionality is enabled. Moreover, NETIM® can refuse any transfer that has not first been notified by registered mail with acknowledgement of receipt.

SECTION FR.5: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

FR.5.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, NETIM® shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "redemption" status for a period of seven (7) calendar days.

FR.5.2 If a Domain Name has been destroyed with the past seven (7) calendar days, it can be registered again subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to NETIM® when carrying out these procedures:

- i) restoration is only possible from a technical point of view for the so-called "redemption" period, which is the seven (7) day period between the destruction of the Domain Name by the Registry and its liberation.
- ii) only NETIM® has the possibility to register the Domain Name during the redemption period.
- iii) payment for the restoration must be made at least (2) days before the liberation of the Domain Name by the Registry, to enable NETIM® to carry out the operation within the time limit. Failing this, the Domain Name might not be restored and NETIM® cannot be held responsible on these grounds.
- iv) the restoration procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by one (1) year the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the new date of registration.

SECTION FR.6: MANAGEMENT OF DISPUTES

FR.6.1 The AFNIC prescribes specific regulations and an alternative procedure for settling differences concerning domain names in .FR, stipulated in the naming charter called "PARL", available for consultation at the following address:

FR.6.2 The Client agrees to have acknowledged these principles and regulations and undertakes to respecting them (below the "PARL regulations"), integrated by means of a hyperlink to these special terms and conditions.

SECTION FR.7: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FR.7.1 Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .FR extensions are imposed by the Registry in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM®'s control.
