

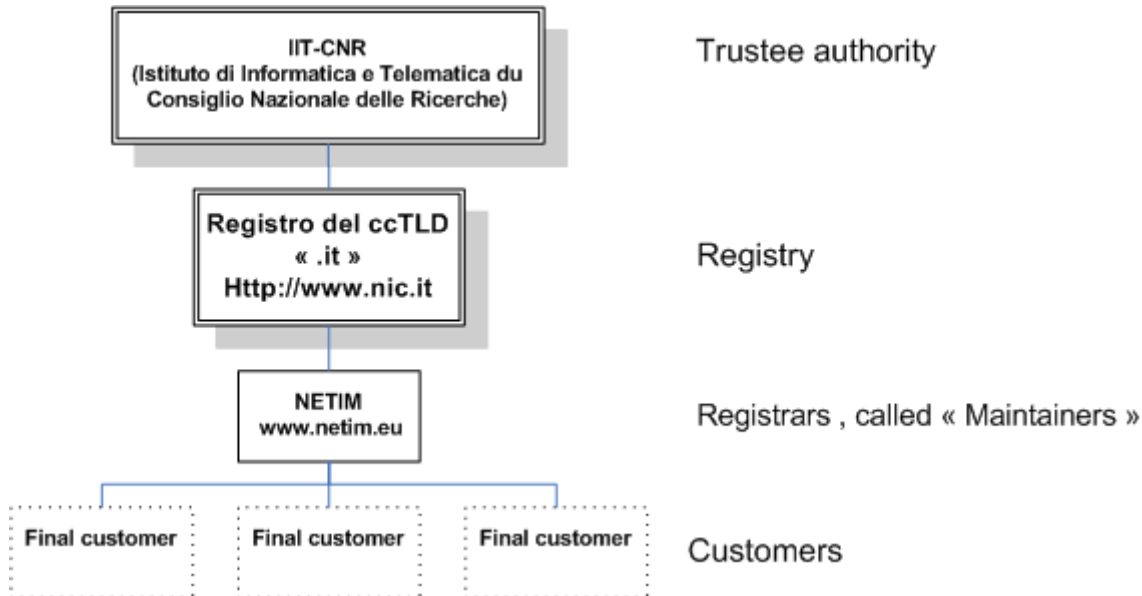
ANNEXE IT - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTLD .IT

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .IT Extension implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-IT.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

SECTION IT.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

IT.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for this Extension



IT.1.2 NETIM® is accredited by the Registry (the "NICIT" below) and act as an official registrar for the management of .IT domain names. NETIM® is recognized as the maintainer NETIM-MNT

SECTION IT.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

IT.2.1 Domain Names under this Extension are registered on a "first come, first served" basis

IT.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws as well as the regulations specific to the Extension, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted these contractual documents (the "DNS IT Regulations" below) which link him to NICIT. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

IT.2.3 For the registration of a new domain name, the registrant must complete and sign the document LAR ("Letter of Assumption of Responsibility") in its Italian version. NETIM® will send this document with its English version and explanatory notes, at the email address of the Client.

The document must be forwarded to the Register by one of the way mentioned in explanatory notes, including:

- By FAX directly to NICIT
- By post directly to NICIT
- By electronically directly to NETIM®, provided that the document is in the format specified in the notes.

IT.2.3 The Client recognizes that the registration is accepted when the Registry has confirmed the receipt of the document LAR and checked its validity. The responsibility for NETIM® may not be incurred if the domain name is no longer available when the document LAR is received by the Registry. Article 4.3 of CG-ND are applying in this fact.

IT.2.4 In case of rejection of document LAR by the Registry, NETIM® transmits all anomalies to the Client

IT.2.4 Regardless of document LAR, NETIM® requests the registration of the domain name only if the conditions of Article IT3.2 are met.

IT.2.5 the Registry can request additional documentary proof of the registrant's declarations. Should it fail to receive such required documentation within established guidelines, the Registry can delete the domain name;

SECTION IT.3: SPECIAL REQUIEREMENTS

IT.3.1 Regarding NICIT Regulations, the owner must reside in one of the UE countries.

IT.3.2 Regarding NICIT Regulations, the name servers (DNS) of the domain name must be correctly configured as specified in the Registry's technical specifications:

IT.3.3 Most of the operations (such as registration, transfer, ownership change, trade, deletion before expiration) require that the owner send a formal request to the Registry, in the Italian language, within the specified deadline. Some particular cases also require special documented proof in paper.

SECTION IT.4: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

IT.4.1 The Client initiates through the intermediary of NETIM® a transfer request for a Domain Name in .IT from another registrar to NETIM® (also referred to as "incoming transfer"), according to the procedure specified on our site, and in compliance with NICIT Regulations:

IT.4.2 The transfer does not take effect immediately. The Client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must approve the transfer to the registry following a format specified.

IT.4.3 If the Client refuses or does not approve the transfer according to the terms stipulated by the Registry, the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM®

SECTION IT.5: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

IT.5.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, NETIM® shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall then be disabled for a period of thirty (30) calendar days during which all NETIM®'s associated services shall no longer be available. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "quarantine" status

IT.5.2 If a Domain Name has been destroyed with the past thirty (30) calendar days, it can be reactivated subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to NETIM® when carrying out these procedures:

- i) restoration is only possible from a technical point of view for the so-called "quarantine" period, which is the thirty (30) day period between the destruction of the Domain Name by NETIM® and its destruction by the Registry
- ii) payment for the restoration must be made seven (7) days before the destruction of the Domain Name by the Registry, to enable NETIM® to carry out the operation within the time limit. Failing this, the Domain Name might not be restored and NETIM® cannot be held responsible on these grounds.
- iii) the restoration procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by one (1) year the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the previous expiry date.

SECTION IT.6: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

IT.6.1 Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .IT extensions are imposed by the Registry in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM®'s control.
